Aldo Hernández Valdés

Aldo was arrested on 22 December 2022, accused of attacking the National Directorate of Gendarmerie with an explosive device in December 2021. He is charged with the attack and 16 counts of attempted homicide, as there were prison guards in the building at the time of the detonation, and charges of possession of weapons and ammunition during the raid. Under investigation, awaiting trial.

Aleksandr Belov

An anarchist from Belarus who was detained on 29 July 2021 and arrested on charges of organisation of actions that disrupted public order during postelection protests in Belarus and participation in an extremist organization. On 22 April 2022 sentenced to 5 years in prison.

Aleksandr Snezhkov

On October 31st 2022, two anarchist teenagers from Chita, Russian Far East, a 19-year old Aleksandr Snezhkov and a 16-year old Lyubov Lizunova were arrested for writing a graffiti "Death to the regime". They were also suspected of administrating a telegram channel with anarchist and anti-war content. They were soon released pending trial, but after an unsuccessful attempt to escape, Aleksandr Snezhkov was transferred to a remand prison, and Lyubov Lizunova was taken under house arrest. Moreover, the case has a third suspect, whose name has so far not been published by the authorities.

Aleksandr Zaitzev

Alexander Zaitsev was detained after attempting to set fire to Chairman of the Supreme Court's summerhouse (Attempted act of terrorism by a group of persons) on 22 August 2021. According to our information his accomplice was a provocateur Akulich Dmitry, whom Zaitzev had met while serving an administrative arrest. On 15 April 2022 Aleksander was sentenced to 10 years in prison.

Alexey Rozhkov

Alexey Rozhkov is an anarchist, he became the third in Russia to set fire to the military enlistment office after the full-scale invasion of the Russian army into Ukraine. He left Russia for Kyrgyzstan, fearing that his action will be classified as "terrorist act", but got kidnapped and sent back to Russia by Kyrgyzstani secret services after several months of life in Kyrgyzstan. Now he's being tried under articles on "attempted damage to property" (up to 3 years and 8 months in prison), but there's possibility for reclassification as "terrorist act" (from 10 years minimum).

Alfredo Cospito

Alfredo Cospito (born 1967) is an Italian anarchist. In 2012 he was sentenced to 10 years for kneecapping the head of the Italian nuclear power company Ansaldo Nucleare. Whilst imprisoned, he was convicted of the 2006 bombing of a Carabinieri barracks in which nobody was harmed. The Supreme Court of Cassation later increased the sentence to life without parole. In 2022, Cospito was placed into the 41-bis prison regime, which involves solitary confinement for 22 hours every day. In protest, he began a hunger strike in October 2022. The Supreme Court rejected the appeal against his placement in the 41-bis system in March 2023, then the following month the Constitutional Court ruled in favour of allowing the reduction of Cospito's sentence from life imprisonment to 23 years. In response to the latter, he stopped his hunger strike after 180 days on 19 April 2023; he had lost 50 kg. Cospito commented in court "There is no evidence that we placed the bombs in Fossano [...] Anarchists do not make indiscriminate massacres, because anarchists are not the state".

Amadeu Casellas Ramón

In 1976 Amadeu came into contact with anarchism and began a prolific career as a bank robber. The money went to different causes and he soon earned the nickname "Robin Hood". He was first imprisoned in 1979 and has since been in and out of prison over the years, serving long sentences despite having no blood crimes behind him. After having exceeded his maximum sentence he began a hunger strike with the support of comrades from the Anarchist Black Cross and the CNT. Amadeu was released in 2010, in poor health but full of strength. Unfortunately, in June 2019 Amadeu returned to prison, accused of participating in a theft of 300,000 euros, a fact he has always denied. In an interview he gave at the end of December he stated that prisons "have gone back 30 or 40 years in rights". He remained behind bars, on remand, for about two years. But, after his trial (in which he was asked to serve 8 years in prison), the Provincial Court decided to release him, waiting for the sentence to be passed and for it to become final. Finally, he was sentenced to 4 years in prison. Amadeu had to go back to prison in June 2023.

Anastasia Kukhta

Anastasia was detained on 17 February 2022 and later was declared a suspect in a criminal case. She was accused of participation in protests, encouraging sanctions or actions aimed at harming the national security of the Republic of Belarus, and creation or participation in an extremist formation. On 11 November 2022, she was sentenced to 5 years in prison.

Andrea Parolari

Andrea has to serve 2 years and 8 months as residual sentence for the convictions of the law enforcement operation named "Operazione Renata" and for another one. Since January 2023, he has been detained in the Spini di Gardolo prison under a 'semi-freedom' regime. His address is:

Andreas Krebs

Andreas is a former rebel long-term prisoner, who was 16 years behind bars until October 2014. He helped build the prisoners' union (GG/BO) behind bars, led various hunger strikes against the lousy conditions in prison and took part in a solidarity hunger strike for prisoners in Greece. In autumn 2014, after his release, he met his current wife Jutta. Both decided to spend a quiet retirement in the south of Italy. At the end of December 2016 there was a dispute with his former employer, who attacked Andreas and strangled him. Andreas stabbed him in self-defence with a penknife. The employer died in the hospital three days later under mysterious circumstances, although it was said shortly after the act that he would survive. In April 2019 he was sentenced in Italy to 24 years for intended murder. Andreas was diagnosed with kidney cancer. Despite this, he did not receive any treatment in prison. After a long struggle, he has finally been transferred to a german prison to be closer to friends and family.

Anna Beniamino

Anna was detained in 2016 and sentenced to 16 years and 6 months of prison as part of the Scripta Manent operation that tried to attribute to a single direction a series of direct actions claimed by the Informal Anarchist Organization.

In particular, the attacks inserted in this investigation include the parcel-bombs sent to the CPT's [detention centres for immigrants] director in Modena in May 2005, to the traffic-cops barracks in

Torino-San Salvario and to the chief-police of Lecce (claimed by FAI/Narodnaja Volja), the explosive device against the RIS barracks [carabinieri forensics] in Parma (October 24, 2005, claimed by FAI/Cooperativa Artigiana Fuoco e Affinioccasionalmente spettacolare), the parcel-bomb sent to the Mayor of Bologna Sergio Cofferati (November 2, 2005, claimed by FAI/Cooperativa Artigiana Fuoco e Affini-occasionalmente spettacolare), the devices against the carabinieri cadets' barracks in Fossano (June 2, 2006, claimed by FAI/RAT-Rivolta Anonima e Tremenda), the devices placed in the Turin neighbourhood, Crocetta (March 7, 2007, claimed by FAI/RAT); among the other actions also the wounding of Adinolfi (May 7, 2012), despite the fact that two comrades have already been convicted and have publicly claimed this attack, to corroborate the crime of association. In June 2023 the Turin court of appeal established the extent of the convictions against Anna Beniamino, sentencing her to 17 years and 9 months.

Azat Miftakhov

Anarchist Azat Miftakhov was detained by law enforcement officers on the morning of February 1, 2019 on suspicion of making explosives and attacking a ruling party office in Moscow. He was sentenced to 6 years in prison and is scheduled to be released on 4 September 2023, if no new charges are brought against him.

Benni

Benni is accused of throwing an incendiary device at the thugs from the USK Dachau (German police unit) on Day X in Leipzig during the protests in response to the verdict in the Antifa Ost trial. In addition to the thousandfold charge of "particularly serious breach of the peace" for simply taking part in the demonstration, he is accused of attempted manslaughter. The investigations and the arrest warrant became known on 23.11.2023, when the cops once again carried out a large-scale raid against the autonomous scene in Leipzig and tried in vain to kidnap him from a court case concerning the LuWi-71 occupation by masked MEK (Mobile police task force). Benni, the comrade condemned to pre-trial detention, did not appear in court that day, which turned out to be a great stroke of luck. He turned himself in on 05.01.24.

However, this was not a voluntary surrender, but rather the bitter realization that freedom ends as soon as his name appears on the arrest warrant.

Bill Dunne

Bill Dunne arrested in 1979 when he and Larry Giddings attempted to free fellow revolutionary Artie Ray Dufur. The two successfully freed Artie, but were arrested after an exchange of fire with police as they were fleeing the scene. Bill and Larry were charged with auto theft and aiding and abetting the escape, for which Bill received an 80-year federal prison sentence. In 1983, Bill attempted to escape prison and was sentenced to a further 15 years in prison. Bill spent seven and a half years in lockdown at the infamous maximum security Marion prison for his attempted prison break.

Bima Satria Putra

On December 3, 2021, Bima (anarchist writer from Indonesia) and Krisna were arrested by the police for bringing 15 kg of dried marijuana from Aceh. Bima was sentenced to 15 years in prison, a subsidiary of 6 months based on the results of the trial verdict on April 13, 2022. He is still continuing his interdisciplinary historical research project and anarchist anthropological theoretical approach to a stateless society in the archipelago from behind bars with research that relies entirely on library research without observations and field visits. "Hingga Semua Penjara Rata dengan Tanah" (Until All Prisons are Flattened to the Ground) is a memoir that he wrote regularly during his

sentence, chronicling his new journey and struggles in Indonesian prisons, trying to dismantle the rot and get rid of the wrecks of the Indonesian prison system.

In his own words:

Given the state's repressive policies to regulate what we consume and what we don't, and that my actions are motivated by more radical motives than just financial matters, I claim to be not only a narcotics prisoner, but also a political prisoner.

Casey Brezik

Casey Brezik is an anarchist from the Kansas City area. In 2010, anarchist Casey Brezik tried to assassinate the governor of Missouri. In June 2013, he was convicted and sentenced to a dozen years on each of three counts – assault and two armed criminal action charges – and seven years on a second count of assault. All sentences will run concurrently. In 2022, Casey was set to be released on parole but was charged with assaulting a guard. He plead guilty and is looking at serving an additional 2-3 years of a 5 year sentence. He is currently at Daviess/Dekalb County Jail awaiting transfer to a longer-term facility.

Christos Rodopoulos

Most of the CCF prisoners are currently involved in a series of new trials dealing with the 250 bombings and arsons between 2008 and 2011 alleged against the organisation (including attacks on the Golden Dawn's offices, the Athens Administrative Court, and Koridallos prisons), as well as the sending of a series of 14 parcel bombs. All are also under investigation concerning the 'Phoenix' project and the 'Operation Ardire' case. On July 8, 2016, the Koridallos prison court – presided over by special judge Asimina Yfanti – convicted all members of the anarchist revolutionary organisation Conspiracy of Cells of Fire (CCF). Christos Rodopoulos was sentenced to 75 years in prison.

Claudio Lavazza

Claudio Lavazza has spent his entire life in the underground anarchist struggle, taking part in armed attacks, expropriations, liberations of other combatants and in diffusing anarchist propaganda in many ways in Italy and elsewhere. He was arrested in 1996, in a bank robbery in Cordoba (Spain), during which two cops were shot dead.

The comrade has a whole of 118 years prison sentence, 11 years for an armed occupation of the Italian consultant's office in Malaga, in order to send a message of solidarity to the anarchists prosecuted for the "Marini" case in Italy, 77 years from Italian courts and 30 years from a court in France. At the moment, he is trying to get released upon 25 years spent in prison through a cumulation of sentence.

Davide Delogu

Davide is an anarchist from Sardinia. He was arrested in 2010 and sentenced to 18 years in prison on charges of theft and attempted homicide allegedly of someone, who was trying to stop him from leaving the scene of a robbery. In 2011 made an unsuccessful attempt to run away from prison and has another case started because of it. On May 1, 2017 made another attempt to escape from prison, but failed again. He was put in isolation for half a year, and the anarchist went on hunger strike. Trials for attempted evasion of Buoncammino prison (Cagliari) in 2010 as well as for an attempted escape from Augusta prison (Siracusa) in 2017 are still underway. He's also having a trial for riots that happened in Buoncammino prison in 2013, where he was held at the time.

Denis Kozak

Denis Kozak from Rostov-na-Donu has been detained in Kazakhstan since 9 February 2023, formally "for violating immigration regime". In 2022, Kozak was charged with "justification of terrorism" due to comments he allegedly made about the suicide bombing by anarchist Mikhail Zhlobitsky against the FSB security services. An extradition request by Russia is currently being processed by the Kazakhstan authorities, and Kozak has also requested asylum in Kazakhstan. Kozak spent his 20th birthday on the 1st of April in prison. He has been involved in numerous anarchist projects online, such as Anarcho News, Russian Syndicalism and RAVANCHE.

On 9 August 2021, fugitive comrade Dimitris Hatzivasiliadis was captured in Thessaloniki, where he attempted the expropriation of a bank. The capture was not connected with the prior search for the anarchist by the special counterguerrilla mechanisms. Since October 2019, after his injury during the expropriation of a local state casino store in Cholargos (Athens), Dimitris went into a state of flight from the grid of preventive and penal repressive control.

On 22 April 2022 sentenced to 5 years in prison. He reported tortures (plastic bag on the head, beatings, etc.)

Fotis was detained on 12 May 2015 and accused of armed robbery and attempted homicide of DIAS cops. A month after the arrests a snitch, also accused of the robbery, gave the comrade's name and signed everything the cops told him to. The last pieces of the puzzle were filled in by well-wishing citizens and cops, who with their testimonies contributed once more to a vengeful arrest of a comrade.

Francisco Solar Domínguez

In the early hours of Friday, 24 July 2020, a number of searches took place in Santiago, Chile, and two anarchists, Francisco Solar and Mónica Caballero, were arrested, accused of several actions with explosive devices between 2019 and 2020. Specifically, both are accused of the double explosive attack that took place inside the Tánica building, a former Transoceánica real estate agency, in the wealthy municipality of Vitacura, on 27 February 2020, an action claimed by the Afinidades Armadas en Revuelta (Armed Affinities in Revolt). While only Francisco is accused of the shipment of two parcel bombs: the first against the 54th police station of Huchuraba, in the northern area of Santiago, which on 25 July 2019 caused the injury of eight policemen; the second to the offices of Quiñenco, against the former Minister of the Interior Rodrigo Hinzpeter, in the municipality of Las Condes, which arrived on the same date but was defused. Their trial started in July 2023.

Gage Halupowski

Gage was arrested at a counter demonstration against a far-right rally in Portland, Oregon on June 29th, 2019 and had been locked up at the local county jail since that day with a high bail. Then on November 1st Gage accepted a non-cooperation plea deal, plead guilty to an assault charge, and was sentenced to nearly 6 years in prison. On November 29th Gage arrived at the prison where he'll most likely be doing the majority of his time in Ontario, Oregon which is out by the Idaho border.

If you're looking for different ways to engage with Gage when sitting down to write that first letter, here are a few things to keep in mind – not only is he an anti-fascist but he also is a radical environmentalist and an anarchist. So,

discussing history, politics or the ideologies of those movements as well could be a good place to start.

In his own words:

"On September 24th and about 9 years after I had to violate my probation, I was arrested outside my house in Volos together with my wife Maria Theofilou right before the eyes of our two infant children. It is true that I have participated in some bank robberies, however I have not participated in all the ones I am accused of, or I will be accused of. The robberies I participated in were always well organized and demanded many months of planning therefore even if I wanted to, I could not be involved in so many."

On February 15, 2016 began the second trial concerning robberies accused of since 2002. The sentence from this case of up to 25 years will run consecutively with the previous sentence of 36 years.

Giovanni Barcia

In the Case of the Cordoba 4 the Malaga court of appeal sentenced the anarchists Giovani Barcia, Michele Pontolillo and Claudio Lavazza, already sentenced to 11 years on September 1999, for an incident in the Italian vice-consulate in December 1996. Three persons wearing balaclavas imprisoned the consul and an employee, sending a message of solidarity to the Italian prisoners jailed by the Judge Marini (the judge who built a false accusation against Italian anarchists) and disappeared with passports and some money. These three Italians were convicted of this, as well as a previous bank robbery with sentences of 49 years for Claudio, 48 years for Giorgio and Giovanni, 3 years for Michele.

Jennifer Amelia Rose is an anti-authoritarian trans woman and insurrectionist amazon held captive for over 25 years for armed robberies and a 1995 attack on a district attorney and associate prison warden. She took part in the 1991 Folsom Prison hunger strike, after which she was beaten and tortured, convicted for armed resistance, and sentenced to multiple 25-to-life sentences under the Three Strikes Law. She has spent over ten years in solitary confinement at Folsom and the Pelican Bay Secure Housing Unit. Despite all of this, Jennifer continues to struggle for freedom, remaining a committed anti-authoritarian, anti-imperialist, anti-racist, anti-fascist, and anti-capitalist.

Jessica Reznicek

Jessica Reznicek is a 40 year old land and water defender who has worked with and lived in the Des Moines Catholic Worker Community for the last 10 years. In 2016, Jessica took a stand against the construction of the Dakota Access Pipeline in Iowa. Jessica attended public comment hearings, gathered signatures for valid requests for Environmental Impact Statements, and participated in civil disobedience, hunger strikes, marches and rallies, boycotts and encampments. When the process failed, she concluded the system was

broken, and it was up to individuals to take action and protect the water. She and a fellow Catholic Worker then spent the next couple months disabling construction machinery along the pipeline route. No one was injured by their actions, and the land was protected from the flow of oil for an additional six months. On February 6, 2021, Jessica pleaded guilty to one count of Conspiracy to Damage an Energy Facility and on June 30, 2021 was designated a domestic terrorist by the court and sentenced to 8 years in prison, followed by 3 years supervised probation, and a restitution of \$3,198,512.70 paid to Energy Transfer LLC.

Joaquín Garcia Chanks

Joaquín has been convicted for bombing a prison guard training facility in San Bernardo, Chile, along with his comrade Kevin Garrido. They both were arrested the day of the bombing, November 19, 2015, and were held in prison until September 2018, when the court sentenced Kevin to 17 years, and Joaquín to 13. On November 2nd, 2018, Kevin was murdered in prison by another prisoner.

In 2016, while awaiting sentence, Joaquín attacked the former boss the intelligence police during the Pinochet dictatorship inside the prison they both were held in.

John Paul Wootton

John Paul Wootton is a vegan anarchist prisoner and IWW/IWOC member, wrongfully convicted of the murder of a police officer in the "Craigavon 2" case, after a trial before a "Diplock" court, a secret military court with no jury. The case has been supported as a miscarriage of justice by high profile campaigners, legal experts & human rights activists. The prosecution used discredited witnesses, inconclusive forensics, and tampered evidence to secure a conviction that does not stand up to scrutiny. Security services destroyed evidence, intimidated witnesses and defence lawyers.

Marcelo Villarroel, Freddy Fuentevilla and Juan Aliste Vega were arrested in 2009 after a long international manhunt, accused of the robbery of a Santander Bank and the murder of a cop in October 2007. On July 2, 2014, the 3 comrades were sentenced in their absence, having refused to assist in the judicial show, and gave their disposition by video link. Juan was sentenced to 18 years for the homicide of Moyano + 10 years for attempted homicide on the cop Abarca + 14 years for the assault on Santander Bank in Valparaiso and Banco Security for a total of 42 years.

Juan Antonio Sorroche Fernandez

Juan went underground in 2017 after a warrant for his arrest was issued. He was sentenced to one-year imprisonment for false identity on the occasion of an inspection in Val Clarea (Val di Susa). With more trials open and several extra years in prison, he decided to go underground and released a Communiqué from Freedom.

Juan was arrested on May 22, 2019 in Brescia, along with Manu who is being charged with the aiding and abetting. In addition, Juan is accused of unionism with the aim of terrorism and / or the overthrow of the democratic order, a terrorist act with deadly and explosive devices, massacres (§285) for the attack against the party office of "Lega Nord" in Treviso in August 2018, as well as the possession of forged documents (§497bis) and carrying weapons (due to a small knife, §4 of the Law 110/75) accused. Manuel was transferred under house arrest in March 2020. On 9 July 2022, Juan was sentenced to 28 years in jail.

Juan Flores Riquelme

Juan Flores is serving a sentence of 23 years, having been convicted by the Chilean state for incendiary attacks in 2014 claimed by the Conspiracy Cells of Fire & International Conspiracy of Revenge. On July 23, 2014 a CCF cell bombed "The Dominicans" station of the Santiago Metro, and on September 8, 2014 a shopping mall in Las Condes. In both instances, measures were taken to ensure the bombs would not hurt anyone, but in the former a bag containing the bomb was moved by a Metro employee, and in the latter the police ignored a warning call the CCF cell made

10 minutes before the bomb was set to go off. As a result, the attacks ended up injuring people, so the Chilean state was able to claim they were meant to terrorize the population, and used an anti-terrorism law to obtain maximum

sentencing on March 15, 2018 after proclaiming Juan guilty of both attacks. Two other comrades, Nataly Casanova and Enrique Guzman, were initially charged alongside Juan, but after over three years of imprisonment and criminal proceedings were found not guilty on all counts.

Kevan Thakrar

Kevan Thakrar was wrongfully sentenced to a lifetime in prison in 2008, and has been fighting for his freedom ever since. He is one of the prolific prisoners in challenging prison conditions, racism and injustice. He has been subjected to severe torture and solitary confinement in the UK's most highest security prisons – Close Supervision Centres that act as prisons within prisons. He continues to fight for his appeal. He appreciates letters and support via action alerts.

Konstantinos Giagtzoglou

Anarchist comrade Konstantinos Giagtzoglou was arrested on October 28th 2017, while exiting a hideout rented by him under a false identity and while transferring guns and explosive materials. Ntinos is accused of being a member of the Conspiracy of Cells of Fire and for sending parcel bombs to various E.U. officials including the former prime minister of Greece, Loukas Papadimos. The cops' accusations are based on a mixed DNA sample and on the fact that Ntinos was visiting a former anarchist prisoner in Korydallos prison in early 2013. The comrade stated that both renting the flat and transferring the equipment were part of "revolutionary solidarity" and denies all other charges. Dinos was sentenced to a total of 11 years and 2 months' prison without parole.

Kostas Dimalexis

Kostas was arrested on 22 November 2022 on a trumped-up charge of state security. His arrest and prosecution were used as an alibi for the invasion of Prosfygika, which was and still is the real target of the operation and the attempt to criminalize the community.

Kostas Sakkas

Arrested on December 4, 2010 in Nea Smirni case (possession of weapons and explosives). In January 2014 released on bail and went on the run. In December 2014 was sentenced in absentia to 16 years. Was rearrested with Marios Seisidis in August 2016 and sentenced to 2 years and 9 months for using forged documents and car registration plates, car theft and disobedience to authorities. On June 12, 2019, Sakkas was arrested in Thessaloniki with Giannis Dimitrakis and Dimitra Syrianou, during expropriating a guarded money transport that was about to refill an ATM at the university hospital AHEPA. Kostas Sakkas was sentenced to 7 years and 10 months.

Kuyi

This comrade, a minor, was arrested on 25 May in the midst of clashes outside the Liceo de Aplicaciones commemorating the death of anarchist Mauricio Morales. Kuyi was arrested by the police in the midst of the arson attack and the burning of a Transantiago bus.

Marius Mason

Long-time activist in the environmental and labour movements. In March 2008, he was arrested by federal authorities for charges related to two acts of property destruction that occurred in 1999 and 2000; no one was injured in either of them. He accepted a plea bargain and was sentenced on February 5, 2009 to just under 22 years. He is now serving the longest sentence of any "Green Scare" prisoner.

Marcelo Villarroel Sepúlveda

Marcelo was a MAPU Lautaro member and political prisoner in the 1990s. Later, he was charged with taking part in the September 2007 Banco Santander robbery in Valparaíso and the October 2007 Banco Security robbery in Santiago during which repressive agent Luis Moyano died in a shootout while they were making their escape.

After a period as a fugitive, Villarroel was arrested on March 15, 2008 together with Freddy Fuentevilla in Neuquen, Argentina. They were then deported to Chile on December 15, 2009. Freddy and Juan Aliste Vega were charged with the same, and were imprisoned for years awaiting trial and had it regularly postponed. On July 2, 2014, the 3 comrades were sentenced in their absence, having refused to assist in the

judicial show, and gave their disposition by video link. Marcelo was sentenced to 14 years in prison for the assault on Santander Bank in Valparaiso and Banco Security. His cumulative sentence ends in 2056.

Marco Marino "Zac"

Anarchist Comdrade Marco Marino, also known as Zac got arrested and accused of incendiary Attack against Greek Consulate in Italy.

On March 28, two houses, one in Napoli and one in Pozzuoli, were raided and four comrades were taken to the police station, in connection with a 270 bis investigation (anti-terrorist association), which was officialized in May 2022

following several house-searches.

Although the investigation is still ongoing, one comrade was placed under preventive arrest, accused of an arson attack against the Greek consulate in 2021. The prosecution contextualizes this attack within the campaign in solidarity with revolutionary Greek prisoner Dimitris Koufontinas, who at the time was on hunger strike.

The comrade has now been taken to the Secondigliano prison and is placed in the AS2 section (high security unit), while the three other comrades were released. According to the case's files, the timing of the arrest was influenced by the relentless solidarity actions with Alfredo Cospito, an anarchist prisoner currently on hunger strike against the 41 bis regime and life imprisonment without the possibility of parole.

This operation is part of a witch hunt that wants to frame anarchists as a public enemy to be eliminated. In the context of the countless actions in solidarity with Alfredo in Italy and abroad, we clearly see this repressive blow as part of the state's attempt to stifle every and any spark of rebellion.

Matías Jordano Berrocal

Arrested in October 2020 accused of various attacks on the police station between August and October 2020, in the Lo Hermida neighbourhood. He is accused for illicit association, attempted homicide, throwing Molotov cocktails, among other crimes along with other defendants who reached the trial. Matías is the only one who remained in prison and was sentenced to 5 years and 1 day.

Mauro Rossetti Busa

Mauro Rossetti Busa was sentenced to 12 years of imprisonment for fire, evasion and manufacture of explosive material, threats and with the aggravating circumstance of recidivism and social danger. The original attacks took place in the vicinity of the Casapound headquarters and to the Eni distributor in Sant'Anna in 2018. The Eni distributor, the multinational is for some time in the sights of anarchists for activities abroad, and a building near the Casapound headquarters. Mauro Rossetti

Busa had succeeded in Florence, in March 2004, in an attack on a public prosecutor. During the hearing his convictions were unwavering: "I'll send you a pack-bomb, the next one will be for you and these cops," he said. His sentence was commutated to 7 years and 9 months.

Michael Kimble

Michael Kimble is a black, gay anarchist serving a life sentence in Alabama for the murder of a white, homophobic, racist bigot. During his first years of imprisonment, Michael embraced communism, but soon moved away from it and toward anarchy because, as he describes it "anarchism is not about building a hierarchical structure for liberation somewhere in the distant future, but about living your life, now, in a fashion that's liberating." Michael has a long history of both individual and collective struggle against prison authority, and continues to engage in the fight against prison slave labour as part of the Free Alabama Movement.

Mikalai Dziadok

Anarchist and blogger Mikalai Dziadok was detained late in the evening of November 11, 2020. The investigation believes that Dziadok repeatedly called for illegal actions on his Internet pages, including participation in protests and resistance to the cops. Dziadok himself was forced to go underground even before the revolution because of the threat of political persecution. Mikola was sentenced to 5 years in prison and over time transferred to a high-security prison.

In the early hours of Friday, 24 July 2020, a number of searches took place in Santiago, Chile, and two anarchists, Francisco Solar and Mónica Caballero, were arrested, accused of several actions with explosive devices between 2019 and 2020. Specifically, both are accused of the double explosive attack that took place inside the Tánica building, a former Transoceánica real estate agency, in the wealthy municipality of Vitacura, on 27 February 2020, an action claimed by the Afinidades Armadas en Revuelta (Armed Affinities in

Revolt).

Their trial started in July 2023.

Nikita Uvarov

On June 2020, five teenagers were detained in Kansk (Russia), three were later charged with training for a terrorist attack and organising a terrorist community. In fact, they were putting leaflets in support of other imprisoned anarchists, criticised the authorities online and discussed how to make explosives and direct actions. Three people were ultimately convicted (two to probation, and Nikita got 5 years in prison).

Osman, born in 1959 in Samsun, is an anarchist prisoner who spent the last 23 years in prison. Since Osman adopted anarchist ideas in 2003, he also became vegan and supports animal liberation struggles. Osman Evcan was imprisoned in many prisons all over the country during his conviction. He built his life fighting against authoritarian violence and especially the violence and oppression which is a systemic part of the prison's hierarchical structure, and he still continues his fight against prison's oppressive mentality, without giving an inch, aspiring to the right standards for anarchist, vegan, libertarian individuals. The worst scenario for his release is 2028.

His indigenous name is Oso Blanco or Yona Unega in Cherokee. He was known to the FBI as 'Robin the Hood' because he informed the bank tellers he was expropriating funds to assist the poor and indigenous people fighting for independence in the southern Mexican state of Chiapas.

On April 10, 2010, Gournas, Maziotis and Roupa were arrested on the charges of membership in the armed organisation Revolutionary Struggle. After Roupa and Maziotis were released on bail in October 2011, they went on the run. In April 2013 Pola Roupa was sentenced to 50.5 years of jail while hiding. In 2014 Nikos Maziotis was seriously wounded in the skirmish with police and arrested. In February 2016 Pola Roupa tried to set him free using a helicopter, but the attempt failed. In January 2017 Pola was arrested in a secret flat where she was hiding with her 6-year old

child and another woman. In July 2018 Pola received life sentence plus 25 years in court. In 2021, the sentence was commuted to 6 years.

Sardinian anarchist and independence activist arrested on 31 October 2017 following an armed robbery at a post office in Cagliari. Pierlotero Fallanca

Pierlotero Fallanca was arrested in July 2023 to serve a 6-year sentence following the Cassation court decision for the process of "Operazione Panico",

a law enforcement operation started in 2017.

He was accused with other people, among other things, of placing a bomb outside a Casapound fascist's bookshop in Florence, where it exploded, injuring a bomb disposal expert who approached it without safety protection, losing the use of an eye and some fingers.

He is now imprisoned in Milano Opera prison. His address is:

Rainer Loehnert

Rainer Loehnert is 60 years old and has been locked up for more than 36 years in various prisons and mental houses, of which he has long been in isolation and on "secured stations". He is currently held in the forensic psychiatry in Bedburg-Hau (North Rhine-Westphalia). Rainer was admitted to a closed psychiatry by means of a "determined incapacity and negative danger prognosis according to section 63 of the Criminal Code" due to a personal injury that he suffered 37 years ago. This resulted in an unofficial, seemingly endless "preventive detention" and long-term overdose of psychotropic drugs. During his entire detention, Rainer's anti-fascist and anti-authoritarian attitudes, actions and acts of resistance were repeatedly pathologized as "morbid" and "delusional".

He opposed his unbroken will to defend himself against this prison System to the humiliation and terror of nurses, doctors, therapists, assessors, judges, etc. and other prisoners (neo-Nazis). The fights have cost him a lot of strength and nerves. In the three decades Rainer went on hunger strikes, attempted several escape attempts, and resisted various police units as well as provocations of the staff and fellow neo-Nazi prisoners.

He participated in the hunger strike in solidarity with the struggling Prisoners in Greece in July 2014, and has repeatedly denied medication and urine checks, what is often punished with solitary confinement or fixation, forced medication.

Rainer writes and reads very much, and expressing solidarity with various struggling (ex)prisoners, such as Marco Camenisch and Gabriel Pombo da Silva. He keeps or seeks contact, among others, with some anti-prison projects and individuals and informs himself about current (anti-domination) fights. He tries get in touch with (fighting) people from inside and outside of prison around the world. Rainer speculates about current (anarchist) struggles, especially in Europe, as well as anarchist newspaper projects, but also "classics" of anarchist theories and practices.

He refused any further support in the form of lawyers, saying that he will be rotting in prison for years and lawyers cannot change the outcome of his case.

Ruslan Sidiki Kasemovich

You can send letters through the on-line service https://prisonmail.online. At the end of November, the anarchist Ruslan Siddiqui was arrested on suspicion of organising the derailment of a goods train in Ryazan province. On 2 December, the Dorogomilovsky district court in Moscow sent Ruslan to pretrial detention.

Ruslan has now been charged with a "terrorist act" (Article 205 of the Criminal Code of the Russian Federation, parts 2.a and 2.v) and "possession of explosive material" (Article 222.1, part 3.a). He is threatened with between 12 and 30 years' imprisonment.

Ruslan's comrades have contacted the anti-war human rights initiative Solidarity Zone. This is how they described him: "As one mutual comrade said, 'Ruslan is a person of action'. And that's really it: Ruslan undertakes difficult tasks, without wasting words. He grasps the essence of any situation quickly and works out how to respond. As a friend he is always responsive, always ready to help. He loves adventure sports such as trekking and cycling marathons. He has travelled many times to the Chernobyl and Belarussian Exclusion Zones [established after the nuclear explosion in 1986, now uninhabited, richly forested areas].

Ruslan is a proponent of anarchist ideas, and the Russian military aggression

against Ukraine distressed him greatly. All the more so because some of his friends and comrades died in that conflict, and people continue to die there. And now he himself has become a victim of state violence, and our support is important to him".

Ryan Dwyer and **Ryan Roberts** two anarchists are part of the Kill The Bill - prisoners.

What happened on 21st March 2021 was an outpouring of rage against the violence of the police. The crowd fought back after police officers attacked the crowd with batons and riot shields. Pepper spray was used indiscriminately, people were charged at with horses and hit over the head with batons and shields. The protesters fought back, seizing police riot shields, helmets and batons to defend themselves. By the end of the evening several police vehicles had been set on fire.

Those who defended themselves against the police have been branded 'thugs' and 'wild animals' by both Priti Patel and the police spokesperson. The police have been out for revenge for what happened at Bridewell ever since. That revenge has come in the form of the brutality used against the Kill the Bill protests in Bristol on March 23rd and 26th. And in the use of riot charges – the most serious public order charge available in English law punishable by a maximum of ten years in prison – against those who fought back on March 21st.

Ryan Dwyer was sentenced to 4 years 6 months years and Ryan Roberts 14 years in prison.

Samantha Faulder

Samantha Faulder was wrongfully sentenced to a life in prison, she has served over 15 years while fighting for an appeal despite huge barriers in the legal system. She is an anarchist who constantly supports other prisoners get through their sentences. Sam's story highlights intersecting challenges of mental health, trauma, addiction and a corrupt criminal justice system in which there is no even playing field. She was diagnosed with cancer in 2016, beginning a long journey of medical neglect in the prison system where access to treatment faced significant delays and disruption. Saveli Frolov

Saveli Frolov is a children and youth sport instructor from Narodo-Fominsk of the Moscow region, who attempted to leave Russia for Georgia on October the 30th. He was arrested on the border, and detained first for frivolous charges of "refusing orders of the border guards" and then "minor hooliganism". Then on the 2nd of December he was charged for allegedly "attempting to cross to side of the enemy". According to authorities, he planned to leave Russia to join the Free Russia Legion, which is fighting on side of Ukraine against Russia. He may face up to 10 years in prison.

Since the begin of the war, Saveli has joined in anti-war actions and was imprisoned for 10 days for distributing anti-war leaflets.

Sean Swain

Sean Swain is a hostage held by a lawless rogue-state calling itself "The State of Ohio." He has been held without legal conviction or sentence since 1991 for the self-defence killing of a court official's relative who broke into Sean's home and threatened his life. In fall of 2012, prisoners calling themselves the Army of the 12 Monkeys (A12M) got rowdy at Mansfield Correctional, and the prison authorities assumed "that anarchist" Sean Swain must have been behind it and threw him in supermax isolation. Sean denies any involvement or affiliation with the A12M and is in the process of suing the ODRC for targetting him based exclusively on his ideology and political speech. Sean is the only son of a retired auto worker and stay-home mom. He has renounced his high

school diploma, his college degree, and his honourable discharge from the U.S. military. Before being taken hostage, Sean worked as a newspaper columnist and as a union organizer.

Sofia Johnson

The she/they insurrectionist enby of your dreams. Write me about the Miami Heat, Friedrich Nietzsche, or come park your car. I'm 25, single, a fan of roses that are black and things that go boom.' Sofia 'Candle' Johnson's sentence is largely driven, time-wise, by her conviction in relation to her robbery of a 7/11 in Beaverton, Oregon; she robbed the cashier at gunpoint for around-\$860 and a handful of Backwoods cigars. Though she succeeded in fleeing from the police, she was later indicted while in custody pertaining to charges that arose from her squatting of a vacant veterinary clinic. She accepted a plea-agreement of the mandatory-minimum, 90-months, per §ORS 137.700. All of her convictions run concurrently, meaning Sofia's hard-release date is set as 12/22/2028. She has no remorse for her acts and holds the State in contempt. Sofia is an intellectual, and though her acts arose of necessity they were not born of impulse. She believes it is always time to act, even alone, that no act is more or less significant than another.

Spyros Christodoulou

On May 29th 2015, during an anti-terrorist operation of the Greek police in the area of Nea Anchialos in Magnesia (in close distance to the city of Volos), Spyros Dravilas fell dead inside a safe house under unverified circumstances. The police operation against dubbed 'Distomo robbers' resulted not only in the death of Spyros Dravilas (an illegalist and ex-prisoner in struggle), but also in the arrest of Grigoris Tsironis (an anarchist comrade, very active over the past two decades, who was on the run since 2006) and Spyros Christodoulou (an illegalist and unruly ex-prisoner).

On 8 February 2022, comrades Thanos Xatziagkelou and Georgia Voulgaris were arrested on the occasion of an arson attack at the Foundation for National and Religious Reflection and in the afternoon of the same day, comrade Panos Kalaitzis was arrested with a unique connection between his friendly and comradely relations with the former. In the following days the charges were upgraded to formation and membership of the Anarchist Action Organization. Georgia and Panos were released with restrictions after 7 months of imprisonment and are awaiting trial.

The comrage was arrested on 20 May 2022, when, after an identity check, a confrontation took place in which two policemen were shot and wounded. The comrade is accused of carrying a weapon, ammunition and frustrated double homicide. He is under investigation, awaiting trial.

Toby Shone

Toby Shone is an anarchist who was imprisoned in Wandsworth, Bristol and G4S Prison Parc for nearly two years accused of being the administrator of counter-information project 325.nostate.net. After the political prosecution failed and the cops had to drop the case 5 days before trial in October 2021, Toby received a sentence of 3 years 9 months for possession of psychedelic medicines. He was released on 28 December 2022 under heavy restrictions (license conditions), oversight by a multi-agency team (MAPPA) including the National Security Division (counter-terror) and was forced to live in a filthy bail

hostel in Gloucester for 9 months. He had just moved back into a flat in the Forest of Dean in Gloucestershire 9 days ago.

On the morning of September 19, 2023, he was driving to an appointment with his probation officer when he was pulled over and arrested by an armed police unit in-between the Forest of Dean and Gloucester. He was taken to HMP Bristol after being accused of being in possession of an [unauthorised] phone and attending a dinner and prisoner letter writing night at BASE anarchist social centre in Bristol in August.

He has since been moved 265 kilometres from his home in Forest of Dean, Gloucestershire and nearly 300 kilometres from support in Bristol to HMP Garth in Leyland, a high security prison near Manchester. Despite being in the resettlement part of his sentence, a vengeful probation and counter-terror team are attempting to isolate Toby from his perceived support base and loved ones in the south of the country and deliberately place him at risk of harm in a notoriously violent Category B prison for those serving sentences of 10 years or more. Probation has demanded Toby serve the rest of his sentence which is just short of 13 months, due for release on 11 November 2024.

Toni Chavero Mejías

Toni Chavero (TC) is from Madrid, is 52 years old and has been in and out of prison since 1996, always for robbery-related convictions and some confrontation with the jailers. Between one thing and another, he has been in prison for more than twenty years and is to be released in 2026. In his own words, he was "a politoxicomano (poly-drug user) until I opened my eyes and started to fight". He is in contact with comrades in Madrid, Asturias and Lleida and also with Gabriel Pombo. His mail is tapped.

Xinachtli is a Chicano-Mexicano, anarchist political prisoner sentenced to 50 years in prison for aggravated assault on an officer when he disarmed a sheriff attempting to shoot him. Since in April 2016, he has been going by his chosen name Xinachtli, which is Nahuatl for seed.

Yaroslav Vilchevski

On the 4th of January 2023 32-year old Yaroslav Vilchevski was arrested for posting on his telegram channel about the anarchist Mikhail Zhobitski. Radio Liberty has called him an anarchist, but himself he is identifying himself as animal rights activist and musician. Radio Liberty has quoted some of his comments, and he has also criticized the mass mobilization when it was announced in Russia.

Vilchevski organised several music festivals, such as "Rock for the protection of animals", published the zine "Punk revival", and was also involved in Food Not Bombs actions. In autumn 2022 he was admining a group on the Vkontakte social network (similar to Facebook), and due to posts there he was arrested.

The Network Case (Russia)

In October 2017, FSB officers arrested six antifascists who played airsoft in the woods. The FSB planted weapons and explosives in some of their vehicles, and tortured them in pre-trial detention- beating them, hanging them upside down, electrocuting them, and threatening them with even worse. This torture was used to force the arrestees to validate forged testimony professing that they are part of an alleged terrorist "network." At the end of January 2018, four more antifascists were arrested in St. Petersburg. They were also beaten, tortured by means of electrical shock, and forced to agree that they too were members of this invented "network." In January 2019, Igor Shiskin was sentenced to 3.5 years of imprisonment. His case was considered individually as he entered into a plea bargain. In February 2020, Dmitry Pchelintsev received 18 years, Ilya Shakursky 16 years, Arman Sagynbaev 6 years, Andrei Chernov 14 years, Vasily Kuksov 9 years, Mikhail Kulkov 10 years, and Maxim Ivankin 13 years of imprisonment. In June 2020, St. Petersburg's military court sentenced Viktor Filinkov to 7 years and Yuli Boyarshinov to 5.5 years in a penal colony (commuted to 5 years 3 months).

The case of anarchist criminal organisation (Belarus)

Akihiro Khanada-Gaevsky and Alexander Frantskevich were detained on August 12, 2020 and charged with participating in mass riots. Maria Rabkova and Andrei Chepiuk were detained later and over time accused of creating and participating an anarchist criminal organisation. In March 2021, seven more people were detained in Brest and accused of being a chapter of this organisation. In June 2021, several people were also detained as suspects in this case in Grodno, but were released after 10 days. Maria Rabkova doesn't want to be associated with anarchism. In September 2022 they were convicted to 5 to 17 years of imprisonment.

The case of the Belarusian anarcho-partisans

Sergey Romanov, Dmitry Rezanovich, Dmitry Dubovski and Igor Olinevich were arrested on the night of 28-29 October 2020 close to Ukrainian border by Belarusian border guards. Charged with terrorism and illegal possession of firearms. According to prosecutors office, they organized several arson attacks in Soligorsk and Mozyr against state institutions. On 22 December 2022 they were sentenced to 18-20 years in prison.

Discussing a criminal case, radical statements, even conveying news and opinions about Russian military aggression against Ukraine can lead to pressure and the imposition of penalties on the prisoner. Of course, you are free to write whatever you want, but try to formulate your message in such a way that it does not harm the recipient. The letter can also be sent online through the volunteer resource https://rosuznik.org/. It's easier and free, and the answer will come to your email in a scanned form. RosUznik project exists only on donations, you can find more information on how to support the project on their website.

If you are writing to prisoners outside of organised solidarity events, find out if it is possible to send letters to the Russian Federation from your region. If impossible, you can scan the message or postcard and send it to abc-msk(at)riseup.net. The activist team in Russia will print out all the material received and send it to the prisoners.
