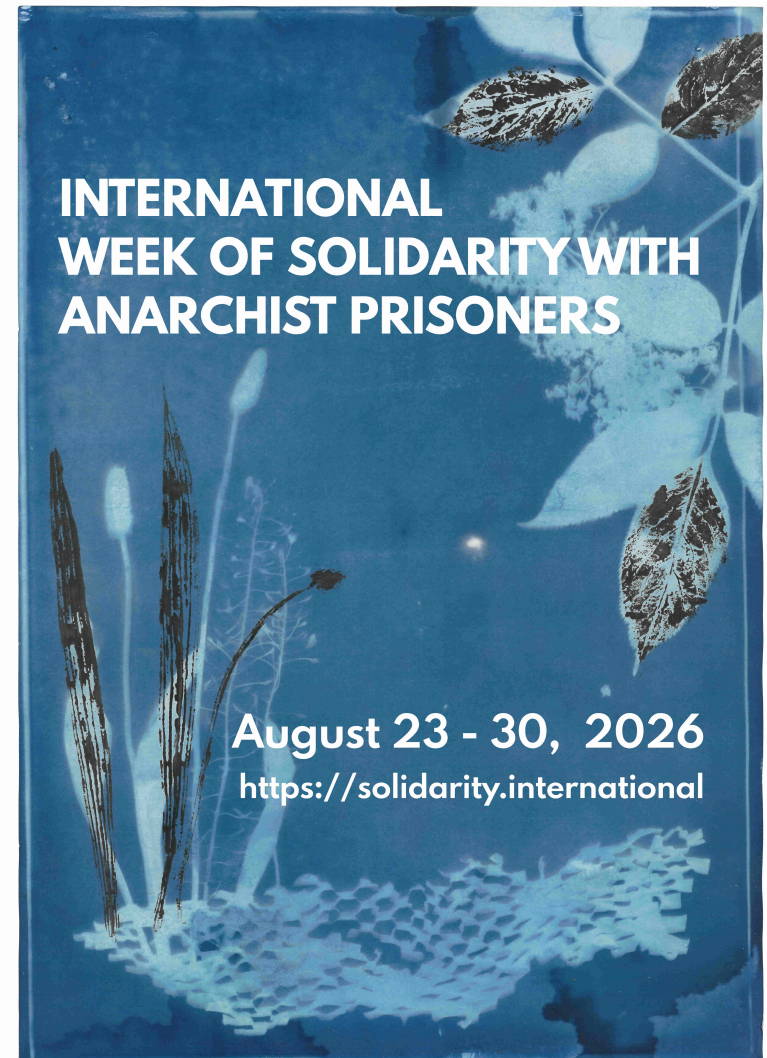

Aditya Muhammad Dena (Apip)

Dena aka Apip, is an anarchist prisoner who was sentenced for one year for rioting in the August 2025 uprising in Indonesia which was triggered when a mobile paramilitary police unit killed a motorcycle courier in Jakarta. Dena is due to be released in September 2026

Aditya Dwi Laksana (Adit)

Adit was sentenced for 3 years for triple small scale explosive attacks against a state building, a police station and a bank, as part of underground revolutionary group "Free Association of Autonomous Fires". Adit was arrested and tortured shortly after the August 2025 uprising as he and several other comrades were subject to surveillance by the anti-terrorist unit.

Aldo Hernández Valdés

Aldo was arrested on 22 December 2022, accused of attacking the National Directorate of Gendarmerie with an explosive device in December 2021. He is charged with the attack and 16 counts of attempted homicide, as there were prison guards in the building at the time of the detonation, and charges of possession of weapons and ammunition during the raid. The trial has begun and, for now, there is a request for an exemplary sentence of 90 year for Aldo.

Aliaksei Halauko

Birthday: 1.01.1999

Sentence: 12 years

Release date: March 2032

We are unaware of Aliaksei's political views, but since he is detained under the anarchists' case, we consider it important to support him in every possible way. Aliaksei was arrested March, 2 2021 together with some other activists who were on the list of politically unreliable ones. Each of the detainees was

charged with gross violation of order (Art. 342) and participation in an international criminal organisation (Art. 285.2).
The grounds for the charges were the anarchists' actions against the accumulator battery factory (blocking the Brest-Minsk highway), the participation of anarchists in the march of «non-parasites» in Brest in 2017 and graffiti. According to the investigation, the activists of the Revolutionary Action in Belarus, Revolutionary Action in Ukraine and People's Self-Defense in Russia created a criminal organization to undermine the regimes.
Aliaksei was sentenced to 12 years.

Aliaksandr Frantskevich

Birthday: 6.05.1990

Sentence: 16 years 9 months

Release date: January 2038

Aliaksandr was detained August 12, 2020. He was charged with organising mass riots, setting up an international criminal organisation of anarchists, inciting hatred against the police, destructing property, and other crimes (a total of 13 articles of the Criminal Code). The international criminal organisation charges was started by cops in February 2021. They claim that the organisation had cells in various cities and countries and was sponsored by informal foundations. A total of 10 people were involved in the Revolutionary Action case, with some five more wanted. September 6, 2022, Aliaksandr was sentenced to 17 years in prison. The sentence was later commuted by three months.

During his detention, cops tried to obtain a confession from Frantskevich by torturing him with a stun gun, and it is known that KGB officers came to the pre-trial detention centre several times, applying pressure for the same purpose. Today his mother is also arrested for «membership in extremist organization».

Aleksandr Snezhkov

On October 31st 2022, two anarchist teenagers from Chita, Russian Far East, a 19-year old Aleksandr Snezhkov and a 16-year old Lyubov Lizunova were arrested for writing a graffiti "Death to the regime". They were also suspected of administrating a telegram channel with anarchist and anti-war content. They were soon released pending trial, but after an unsuccessful attempt to escape, Aleksandr Snezhkov was transferred to a remand prison, and Lyubov

Lizunova was taken under house arrest. Moreover, the case has a third suspect, whose name has so far not been published by the authorities. On April 25, 2024, the 1st District Military Court in a visiting session in Chita sentenced Alexander Snezhkov to 6 years, and Lyubov Lizunova to 3.5 years in prison. On the eve of the debate, the prosecutor asked to appoint Snezhkov 7, Lizunova 5 years. The court also dismissed Lizunova's criminal case of vandalism for graffiti due to the expiration of the statute of limitations on prosecution for minors.

Aliaksandr Zaitsau

Birthday: 08.10.1982

Sentence: 10 years

Release date: April 2031

Aliaksandr was detained on August 22, 2021 near the cottage of the chairman of the Supreme Court. He was accused of attempted arson of the cottage (part 1 of article 14 and part 2 of article 289 of the Criminal Code Attempt of terrorist act in a group of persons). The trial was closed and went on for three weeks. On April 15, 2022, Aliaksandr was sentenced to 10 years of imprisonment in a reinforced regime colony.

Alfredo Cospito

Alfredo Cospito (born 1967) is an Italian anarchist. In 2012 he was sentenced to 10 years for kneecapping the head of the Italian nuclear power company Ansaldo Nucleare. Whilst imprisoned, he was convicted of the 2006 bombing of a Carabinieri barracks in which nobody was harmed. The Supreme Court of Cassation later increased the sentence to life without parole. In 2022, Cospito was placed into the 41-bis prison regime, which involves solitary confinement for 22 hours every day. In protest, he began a hunger strike in October 2022. The Supreme Court rejected the appeal against his placement in the 41-bis system in March 2023, then the following month the Constitutional Court ruled in favour of allowing the reduction of Cospito's sentence from life imprisonment to 23 years. In response to the latter, he stopped his hunger strike after 180 days on 19 April 2023; he had lost 50 kg.

Anastasia was detained on 17 February 2022 and later was declared a suspect in a criminal case. She was accused of participation in protests, encouraging sanctions or actions aimed at harming the national security of the Republic of Belarus, and creation or participation in an extremist formation.

On 11 November 2022, she was sentenced to 5 years in prison.

Andreas Krebs

Andreas is a former rebel long-term prisoner, who was 16 years behind bars until October 2014. He helped build the prisoners' union (GG/BO) behind bars, led various hunger strikes against the lousy conditions in prison and took part in a solidarity hunger strike for prisoners in Greece. In autumn 2014, after his release, he met his current wife Jutta. Both decided to spend a quiet retirement in the south of Italy. At the end of December 2016 there was a dispute with his former employer, who attacked Andreas and strangled him. Andreas stabbed him in self-defence with a penknife. The employer died in the hospital three days later under mysterious circumstances, although it was said shortly after the act that he would survive. In April 2019 he was sentenced in Italy to 24 years for intended murder. Andreas was diagnosed with kidney cancer. Despite this, he did not receive any treatment in prison. After a long struggle, he has finally been transferred to a German prison to be closer to friends and family. This year, he probably suffered a second stroke. He can barely move his left arm and can no longer hear anything in his left ear. Despite these serious health limitations, he continues to be left alone in his cell at night.

Anna Beniamino

Anna was detained in 2016 and sentenced to 16 years and 6 months of prison as part of the Scripta Manent operation that tried to attribute to a single direction a series of direct actions claimed by the Informal Anarchist Organization.

In particular, the attacks inserted in this investigation include the parcel-bombs sent to the CPT's [detention centres for immigrants] director in Modena in May 2005, to the traffic-cops barracks in Torino-San Salvario and to the chief-police of Lecce (claimed by FAI/Narodnaja Volja), the explosive device against the RIS barracks [carabinieri forensics] in Parma (October 24, 2005, claimed by FAI/Cooperativa Artigiana Fuoco e Affini- occasionalmente spettacolare), the parcel-bomb sent to the Mayor of Bologna Sergio Cofferati (November 2, 2005, claimed by FAI/Cooperativa Artigiana Fuoco e Affini-occasionalmente spettacolare), the devices against the carabinieri cadets' barracks in Fossano (June 2, 2006, claimed by FAI/RAT-Rivolta Anonima e Tremenda), the devices placed in the Turin neighbourhood, Crocetta (March 7, 2007, claimed by FAI/RAT). In June 2023, the Turin court of appeal established the extent of the convictions against Anna Beniamino, sentencing her to 17 years and 9 months.

On 4th of August 2021, he was arrested for 15 days for allegedly resisting arrest by the cops. After that he was not released, the criminal case was opened under the Article 342.1 (gross violation of public order) for participation in protests and the Article 361-1.1 (participation in an extremist organization). Earlier Artsiom had been detained several times at marches and preventively before Freedom Day. On April 22, 2022 sentenced to 5 years in prison. On 27 October 2025, sentenced to another year in prison over persistent disobedience to prison administration.

Bill Dunne

Bill Dunne is an anti-authoritarian sentenced to 90 years for the attempted liberation of an anarchist prisoner in 1979. He was arrested in 1979 when he and Larry Giddings attempted to free fellow revolutionary Artie Ray Dufur. The

two successfully freed Artie, but were arrested after an exchange of fire with police as they were fleeing the scene. Bill was charged with possession of an automatic weapon, auto theft, and with aiding & abetting the escape. Charges further alleged the operation was financed by bank expropriations and facilitated by illegal acquisition of weapons and explosives. Bill received an 80 year federal prison sentence. In 1983, Bill attempted to escape prison and was given another 15 years in prison.

Bima Satria Putra

On December 3, 2021, Bima (anarchist writer from Indonesia) and Krisna were arrested by the police for bringing 15 kg of dried marijuana from Aceh. Bima was sentenced to 15 years in prison, a subsidiary of 6 months based on the results of the trial verdict on April 13, 2022. He is still continuing his interdisciplinary historical research project and anarchist anthropological theoretical approach to a stateless society in the archipelago from behind bars with research that relies entirely on library research without observations and field visits. "Hingga Semua Penjara Rata dengan Tanah" (Until All Prisons are Flattened to the Ground) is a memoir that he wrote regularly during his sentence, chronicling his new journey and struggles in Indonesian prisons, trying to dismantle the rot and get rid of the wrecks of the Indonesian prison system.

In his own words: Given the state's repressive policies to regulate what we consume and what we don't, and that my actions are motivated by more radical motives than just financial matters, I claim to be not only a narcotics prisoner, but also a political prisoner.

Peppy” is serving 60 months after his house was raided in the aftermath of an April 18, 2023, demonstration against a University of Pittsburgh-sanctioned event that promoted hatred toward transgender people and communities. The speaking event featured notorious transphobes Brad Polumbo and Michael Knowles, and posed the question, “should transgenderism be regulated by law?” The government alleged that in the protests outside the event, a “civil disorder” occurred, when one commercially available firework and two homemade “smoke bombs” were discharged. Casey Goonan

Casey Goonan (they/them) is a dedicated community educator, writer, distroist, and printer who has committed their life to struggles for liberation. During the spring of 2024, Casey was arrested for alleged actions in solidarity with the Palestinian liberation struggle as part of a global student uprising to protest the genocide in Gaza carried out by the United States, Israel, and its western proxies.

Casey has been incarcerated at Santa Rita Jail since June of 2024 and is currently facing federal felony charges that could result in up to twenty years of imprisonment. They have been involved in prisoner support and abolitionist work for over a decade before their arrest, including anti-prison and anti-police organizing. Please use online translators to compose a message in Russian. Discussing a criminal case, radical statements, even conveying news and opinions about Russian military aggression against Ukraine can lead to pressure and the imposition of penalties on the prisoner. Of course, you are free to write whatever you want, but try to formulate your message in such a way that it does not harm the recipient.

Des isn’t just a victim of trumped-up political prosecution. He’s a beloved artist and friend who loves nothing more than experimenting with new vegan recipes, digging into new books, looking at baby opossums and sometimes fostering them, spitting out bars or writing poetry, and spending time with loved ones. As a longtime vegan dedicated to animal liberation, solidarity with nonhumans shows up in much of Des’s artwork, including through his playful depictions of raccoons, cats, and other critters. Des extends this deep solidarity outward: he’s a loving brother, son, and friend; he’s a free-spirited dreamer who takes good care of everyone and everything around him.

Now stuck in a federal prison and facing potential deportation, Des is continuing to lend solidarity by, among other things, drawing pictures for other inmates to send to their families.

Denis Sergeevich

Denis is one of two boys arrested in 2020, accused of plotting a terrorist attack. According to the charges, they were, among other things, planning to build the headquarters of the Russian security service FSB in Minecraft, and to blow it up there. During the Soviet Era, the FSB had different names, the last before the disintegration of the Soviet union being FSB. Nikita and Denis were arrested after they spread posters demanding the release of anarchist and mathematician Azat Miftakhov, arrested in Moscow. One of the posters was posted on the local FSB building in Kansk. Denis and Nikita were also planning to organize a Food Not Bombs-event in Kansk, to give food to the homeless.

You can write to Nikita and Denis in prison, but in remand imprisonment, there is heavy censorship, and it is better to avoid overtly political themes. Letters must be in Russian.

Dzmitry Zakharoshka was detained in December 2023 together with the other members of the Black Nightingale case.

According to a propaganda film shown on state television in late April 2024, Trafim was an active member of the anarchist cell “Black Nightingales,” whose goal was allegedly to carry out sabotage in Belarus and Russia. In the film, some of the detainees talk about their roles, in particular, claiming that they gathered at an apartment in Baranovichi, where they tried to assemble an explosive device, and later planned to test it.

Aliaksandra Pulinovich was detained on January 12, 2024.

According to a propaganda film shown on state television in late April 2024, Aliaksandra was an active member of the anarchist cell “Black Nightingales,” whose goal was allegedly to carry out sabotage in Belarus and Russia. In the film, some of the detainees talk about their roles, in particular, claiming that they gathered at an apartment in Baranovichi, where they tried to assemble an explosive device, and later planned to test it.

Activists from the Black Nightingales group put up posters and wrote slogans against war and dictatorship, such as “Death to dictatorship,” “A new tsar, a new 1917,” and “Long live Belarus.”

The anarchists were accused of “preparing an act of terrorism” (Article 13, Part 3, Article 289 of the Criminal Code) and “preparing illegal actions involving firearms and explosives” (Article 13, Part 4, Article 295 of the Criminal Code) committed by an organized group, as well as “desecration of structures” (Article 341 of the Criminal Code).

In October 2025, the court sentenced Aliaksandra to 10 years and 3 months of imprisonment.

Dimitra was arrested on suspicion of being connected to the explosion in an apartment in Athens that killed anarchist comrade Kyriakos Xymitiris and seriously injured Marianna Manoura. **Dimitra** and **Marianna** were convicted of terrorist organisation within the framework of the law 187a; specific manufacture of an explosive device; specific possession of explosives and weapons for supply to an organisation; possession and manufacture of explosives in large quantities; explosion with possible intent to damage. Their final sentences are 8 years for Dimitra Zarafeta and 19 years for Marianna Manoura.

Dzmitry got excited about anarchism in his teens. He joined the movement in Soligorsk and was a co-founder and participant of many groups and initiatives. He was propagating ‘militant anarchism’ – an approach which criticized lifestyle activism and subcultural looks that is repellent to the masses and promoted an image of a well-read, strong and charismatic activists who are good at both agitating and fighting cops and neo-Nazis if necessary.

He was critical of the legal movement and decided to participate directly in the Belarusian Uprising 2020.

He was detained while crossing the border of Belarus on the night of October 28-29, 2020 together with the other members of the Black Flag group. During a meeting at the end of December 2021, Dzmitry told his sister that anarcho-partizans were being subjected to torture during the detention. He, together with Dzmitry Rezanovich, Ihar Alinevich and Siarhei Ramanau, was charged under a number of articles for setting fire to government officials’ vehicles, the building of the traffic police and the state committee of expertise in the Homiel region.

On December 22 2021, Dzmitry Dubouski was sentenced to 18 years in the

high-security prison. Before his arrest in October 2020, Dzmitry was on the run for 10 years persecuted for direct actions of 2009-2010. In early September 2022, he was sentenced with 5 years for that (total sentence became 20 years). Dzmitry was put on the list of “terrorists”, which means that he is not allowed to receive money transfers.

Dzmitry Rezanovich

Birthday: 12.11.1989

Sentence: 19 years

Release date: October 2039

Dzmitry Rezanovich was detained while crossing the border of Belarus with Ukraine on the night of October 28-29, 2020. He said they were treated by border guards worse than they usually treat so called «illegal immigrants». Dzmitry also emphasized he was saved from torture just because Siarhei Ramanau sliced his hands with a razor to stop the torment and viciousness. He, together with Ihar Alinevich, Dzmitry Dubouski and Siarhei Ramanau, was charged under a number of articles for setting fire to government officials’ vehicles, the building of the traffic police and the state committee of expertise in the Homel’ region.

On December, 22 2020, Dzmitry was sentenced to 19 years imprisonment under a strengthened prison regime. In February 2021 the KGB put Dzmitry on the list of “persons involved in terrorist activities”. Persons from this list are banned from transferring money. On April, 26, 2024 his had 2 years added for «malicious disobedience to the demands of the colony administration».

Evgeny Rubashko

An anarchist from Belarus who was a member of Food not Bombs Minsk and FreeMarket initiatives and others. He lived in Amsterdam for almost two years before the events of summer 2020 when he decided to come back to Belarus because he couldn’t stay away during the protests.

He was detained on 29 July 2021 and arrested on charges of organisation of actions that disrupted public order during post-election protests in Belarus and participation in an extremist organization. During his detention, he was tortured, including putting a bag over his head, pouring liquid (presumably vodka) into his mouth, and being beaten. His home was searched, after which he was taken to KGB, where the torture continued.

Black Nightingales group

Group of six anarchists arrested in 2023. Black Nightingales were spreading leaflets and making graffiti against the war in Ukraine and Lukashenko’s regime. They first appeared in Belarusian propaganda report allegedly preparing acts of anti-war sabotage in Belarus and Russia. At the time of arrest most of them were underage.

Sentence: 12 years

Trafim Barysau was detained in December 2023 with the other members of the Black Nightingale case. According to a propaganda film shown on state television in late April 2024, Trafim was an active member of the anarchist cell “Black Nightingales,” whose goal was allegedly to carry out sabotage in Belarus and Russia. According to the film, the organization was linked to the “People’s Liberation Army of Ukraine” and the Security Service of Ukraine. In the film, Trafim says that he is an anarchist.

Activists from the Black Nightingales group put up posters and wrote slogans against war and dictatorship, such as “Death to dictatorship,” “A new tsar, a new 1917,” and “Long live Belarus.”

The anarchists were accused of “preparing an act of terrorism” (Article 13, Part 3, Article 289 of the Criminal Code) and “preparing illegal actions involving firearms and explosives” (Article 13, Part 4, Article 295 of the Criminal Code) committed by an organized group, as well as “desecration of structures” (Article 341 of the Criminal Code).

In October 2025, the court sentenced Trafim Barysau to 12 years in prison.

Siarhei Zhygaliou was detained in December 2023 with the other members of the Black Nightingale case. According to a propaganda film shown on state television in late April 2024, Siarhei was an active member of the anarchist cell “Black Nightingales,” whose goal was allegedly to carry out sabotage in Belarus and Russia. According to what Zhyhaliou shared in the film, he rented an apartment in Baranavichy where anarchists gathered. According to the state channel, Siarhei was involved in purchasing components to create a homemade explosive device.

Activists from the Black Nightingales group put up posters and wrote slogans against war and dictatorship, such as “Death to dictatorship,” “A new tsar, a new 1917,” and “Long live Belarus.”

The anarchists were accused of “preparing an act of terrorism” (Article 13, Part 3, Article 289 of the Criminal Code) and “preparing illegal actions involving firearms and explosives” (Article 13, Part 4, Article 295 of the Criminal Code) committed by an organized group, as well as “desecration of structures” (Article 341 of the Criminal Code).

In October 2025, the court sentenced Siarhei Zhyhaliou to 12 years in prison.

Yaroslav Vilchevski

On the 4th of January 2023 32-year old Yaroslav Vilchevski was arrested for posting on his telegram channel about the anarchist Mikhail Zhobitski. Radio Liberty has called him an anarchist, but himself he is identifying himself as animal rights activist and musician. Radio Liberty has quoted some of his comments, and he has also criticized the mass mobilization when it was announced in Russia.
Vilchevski organised several music festivals, such as "Rock for the protection of animals", published the zine "Punk revival", and was also involved in Food Not Bombs actions. In autumn 2022 he was admining a group on the Vkontakte social network (similar to Facebook), and due to posts there he was arrested.

He was initially accused of actively participating in protests in the autumn of 2020 (he was detained on 15 November 2020 and sentenced to 15 days of administrative arrest, after describing the experience in an article).

In January 2022 it became known that Evgeny and the other defendants in the criminal case were additionally charged under Part 3 Article 361-1 of the Criminal Code – participation in an extremist formation for subscribing to the Pramen Telegram channel. It is known that at the time of Rubashko's detention, Pramen was not included in the list of extremist formations, this only happened in November 2021.

Zhenya Rubashko was sentenced on two counts to five years' imprisonment in a penal colony. In March 2023 he was tried again and sentenced to harsher prison conditions.

In October 2025, Zhenya was sentenced to an additional year of imprisonment for allegedly disobeying the prison administration's orders (Article 411 of the Criminal Code).

Francisco Solar Domínguez

In the early hours of Friday, 24 July 2020, a number of searches took place in Santiago, Chile, and two anarchists, Francisco Solar and Mónica Caballero, were arrested, accused of several actions with explosive devices between 2019 and 2020. Specifically, both are accused of the double explosive attack that took place inside the Tánica building, a former Transoceánica real estate agency, in the wealthy municipality of Vitacura, on 27 February 2020, an action claimed by the Afinidades Armadas en Revuelta (Armed Affinities in Revolt). While only Francisco is accused of the shipment of two parcel bombs: the first against the 54th police station of Huchuraba, in the northern area of Santiago, which on 25 July 2019 caused the injury of eight policemen; the second to the offices of Quiñenco, against the former Minister of the Interior Rodrigo Hinzpeter, in the municipality of Las Condes, which arrived on the same date but was defused. Francisco Solar was sentenced to 86 years in prison.

He together with Dzmitry Dubouski, Ihar Alinevich and Dzmitry Rezanovich, was charged under a number of articles for setting fire to government officials' vehicles, the building of the traffic police and the state committee of expertise in the Homiel region.

On December, 22 2020, Siarhei was sentenced to 20 years imprisonment in a maximum-security penal colony (19 years + 1 year for malicious disobedience to the demands of administration of the correctional institution). Siarhei was put on the list of "terrorists", which means that he is not allowed to receive money transfers.

He was several time additionally sentenced for «malicious disobedience to the demands of administration» and his total sentence is 24 years 5 months.

Saveli Frolov is a children and youth sport instructor from Narodo-Fominsk of the Moscow region, who attempted to leave Russia for Georgia on October the 30th 2022. He was arrested on the border, and detained first for frivolous charges of "refusing orders of the border guards" and then "minor hooliganism". Then on the 2nd of December 2022 he was charged for allegedly "attempting to cross to side of the enemy". According to authorities, he planned to leave Russia to join the Free Russia Legion, which is fighting on side of Ukraine against Russia. He may face up to 10 years in prison. Since the begin of the war, Saveli has joined in anti-war actions and was imprisoned for 10 days for distributing anti-war leaflets.

Sean Swain is a hostage held by a lawless rogue-state calling itself "The State of Ohio." He has been held without legal conviction or sentence since 1991 for the self-defense killing of a court official's relative who broke into Sean's home and threatened his life. In fall of 2012, prisoners calling themselves the Army of the 12 Monkeys (A12M) got rowdy at Mansfield Correctional, and the prison authorities assumed "that anarchist" Sean Swain must have been behind it and threw him in supermax isolation. Sean denies any involvement or affiliation with the A12M and is in the process of suing the ODRC for targetting him based exclusively on his ideology and political speech.

Jessica Reznicek

Jessica Reznicek is a land and water defender who has worked with and lived in the Des Moines Catholic Worker Community for the last 10 years. In 2016, Jessica took a stand against the construction of the Dakota Access Pipeline in Iowa. Jessica attended public comment hearings, gathered signatures for valid requests for Environmental Impact Statements, and participated in civil

disobedience, hunger strikes, marches and rallies, boycotts and encampments. Since the end of 2025 Jessica was transfered to halfway house until October 2027.

In addition, Juan is accused of unionism with the aim of terrorism and / or the overthrow of the democratic order, a terrorist act with deadly and explosive devices, massacres (§285) for the attack against the party office of "Lega Nord" in Treviso in August 2018, as well as the possession of forged documents (§497bis) and carrying weapons (due to a small knife, §4 of the Law 110/75) accused. Manuel was transferred under house arrest in March 2020. On 9 July 2022, Juan was sentenced to 28 years in jail, which was commuted to 14 years and 10 months on 28 March 2023 on appeal.

Juan Flores Riquelme

Juan Flores is serving a sentence of 23 years, having been convicted by the Chilean state for incendiary attacks in 2014 claimed by the Conspiracy Cells of Fire & International Conspiracy of Revenge. On July 23, 2014 a CCF cell bombed "The Dominicans" station of the Santiago Metro, and on September 8, 2014 a shopping mall in Las Condes. In both instances, measures were taken to ensure the bombs would not hurt anyone, but in the former a bag containing the bomb was moved by a Metro employee, and in the latter the police ignored a warning call the CCF cell made 10 minutes before the bomb was set to go off. As a result, the attacks ended up injuring people, so the Chilean state was able to claim they were meant to terrorize the population,

and used an anti-terrorism law to obtain maximum sentencing on March 15, 2018 after proclaiming Juan guilty of both attacks. Two other comrades, Nataly Casanova and Enrique Guzman, were initially charged alongside Juan, but after over three years of imprisonment and criminal proceedings were found not guilty on all counts. For the attack on the 'Llega Nord' in Treviso, he was sentenced to a final prison term of 14 years and 10 months (the original sentence was 28 years, but it was not final). In addition, there are a number of penalties for resisting state authority, public disorder, etc., which increased the sentence by 11 years. In October 2024, the trial began in connection with the 2015 bombing of the police academy in Brescia (he faces up to 30 years in prison).

Stecco was arrested on February 19, 2019 as part of Operation Renata. Stecco was jointly accused of an attack on an industrial mathematics and cryptography lab at the University of Trento on April 8, 2017; the arson of a relay antenna on Mount Finonchio on June 7, 2017; of the attempted arson of nine municipal police vehicles in Trento on December 3, 2017; an explosion targeting a bank in Roverto on July 25, 2018, and targeting a temp agency in Roverto as well, on September 1, 2018; and of an explosive device left in front of the Northern Leagues Ala office in October 2018. The cops also accused him of making false documents.

Oso Blanco (Byron Chubbuck)

Oso Blanco is an indigenous activist originally serving 80 years in prison for a series of bank expropriations throughout the southwest in 1998-1999. In 2016, 25 years were taken off his sentence when he won his Johnson v. U.S. appeal. He is part of the wolf clan Cherokee/Choctaw, raised in New Mexico. His indigenous name is Oso Blanco or Yona Unega in Cherokee. He was known to the FBI as 'Robin the Hood' because he informed the bank tellers he was expropriating funds to assist the poor and indigenous people fighting for independence in the southern Mexican state of Chiapas.

Paolo Todde

Sardinian comrade Paolo Todde, who was already persecuted in the first half of the 2000s in the wake of the repression against the anarchist social center FRARIA in Cagliari, has been in pretrial detention since October 23, 2024, for robbery. He had already been arrested several years ago for armed robbery. On April 25 2025, he and other prisoners began a hunger strike to protest the living conditions in the prison in Uta (Sardinia). The intervention of the so-called "guarantors" (comparable to an ombudsman), who made only empty and useless promises, led to the collective hunger strike being called off after less than a week. However, Paolo decided to continue it on his own on May 8, with the clear intention of seeing it through to the bitter end. We would like to point out that Paolo is 64 years old and began the strike weighing only 61 kg. Paolo shares many dreams with us: that of a free Sardinia, hatred of prisons and the society that produces them.

Roman Shvedov

On the 23rd of September 2022 someone threw a firebomb with 3 litres of gasoline to an administration building in the Zimovski municipality of the Rostov region. Roman Shvedov was soon arrested and charged with terrorism. Solidarity Zone organised a lawyer to visit Roman in March, whom he told that he is an anarchist and in very bad spirits. He refused any further support in the form of lawyers, saying that he will be rotting in prison for years and lawyers cannot change the outcome of his case. On December 18, the military court in Rostov sentenced him to sixteen years in a penal colony. Five hours after the sentencing, Shvedov was found dead in his cell by a prison guard.

Nikos Maziotis

Nikos was sentenced to 86 years' imprisonment in absentia in the Revolutionary Struggle case. His sentence was merged into 50 years. However, the maximum prison term is 25 years (which are typically served either as a full sentence or by day wages in prisons, or after the completion of 3/5 of the prison term, when a prisoner can be granted conditional release under specific conditions).

Nikos was on the run for two years, was seriously wounded and arrested on July 16, 2014, after a shootout with cops in Monastiraki. He was then transferred to the tightly-guarded Evangelismos hospital, where he was hospitalised and has since been transferred to the 5th wing of the new type C maximum security prison in Domokos. Prisoners in these special wings may have their mail intercepted and it may not reach the intended recipient. As a member of Revolutionary Struggle, Nikos Maziotis assumed political responsibility for the bombing at the Bank of Greece, framed within the second period in the ongoing action of the organisation. He received a life sentence and 129 years of jail for the formation and management of a terrorist organization, for 5 attempted homicide against police officers, 2 expropriations of banks and charges relating to commission, possession, construction of explosives, dangerous personal injuries, arson, weapons of mass destruction and arming, forgery, etc.

Osman Evcan

Osman, born in 1959 in Samsun, is an anarchist prisoner who spent the last 23 years in prison. In 1992, he was sentenced to 30 years in prison with the charges of being a member of a leftist terrorist group and robbery. He was also imprisoned for 9 years between 1980-1989. Since Osman adopted anarchist ideas in 2003, he also became vegan and supports animal liberation struggles. Osman Evcan was imprisoned in many prisons all over the country during his conviction. He built his life fighting against authoritarian violence and especially the violence and oppression which is a systemic part of the prison's hierarchical structure, and he still continues his fight against prison's oppressive mentality, without giving an inch, aspiring to the right standards for anarchist, vegan, libertarian individuals. The worst scenario for his release is 2028.

Marcelo Villarroel Sepúlveda

Marcelo was a MAPU Lautaro member and political prisoner in the 1990s. Later, he was charged with taking part in the September 2007 Banco Santander robbery in Valparaíso and the October 2007 Banco Security robbery in Santiago during which repressive agent Luis Moyano died in a shootout while they were making their escape.

After a period as a fugitive, Villarroel was arrested on March 15, 2008 together with Freddy Fuentevilla in Neuquen, Argentina. They were then deported to Chile on December 15, 2009. Freddy and Juan Aliste Vega were charged with the same, and were imprisoned for years awaiting trial and had it regularly postponed. On July 2, 2014, the 3 comrades were sentenced in their absence, having refused to assist in the judicial show, and gave their disposition by video link. Marcelo was sentenced to 14 years in prison for the assault on Santander Bank in Valparaíso and Banco Security. His cumulative sentence ends in 2056.

Mikita Dranets

We are unaware of Mikita's political views, but since he is detained under the anarchists’ case, we consider it important to support him in every possible way. Mikita was arrested March, 2 2021 together with some other activists who were on the list of politically unreliable ones. Each of the detainees was charged with gross violation of order (Art. 342) and participation in an international criminal organisation (Art. 285.2)

The grounds for the charges were the anarchists’ actions against the accumulator battery factory (blocking the Brest-Minsk highway), the participation of anarchists in the march of «non-parasites» in Brest in 2017 and graffiti. According to the investigation, the activists of the Revolutionary Action in Belarus, Revolutionary Action in Ukraine and People’s Self-Defense in Russia created a criminal organization to undermine the regimes. Mikita was sentenced to 6 years. In January 2026, Nikita was tried on charges of “malicious disobedience to the prison administration” (Article 411 of the Criminal Code), resulting in an additional year being added to his sentence.

Mónica Caballero Sepúlveda

In the early hours of Friday, 24 July 2020, a number of searches took place in Santiago, Chile, and two anarchists, Francisco Solar and Mónica Caballero, were arrested, accused of several actions with explosive devices between 2019 and 2020. Specifically, both are accused of the double explosive attack that took place inside the Tánica building, a former Transoceánica real estate agency, in the wealthy municipality of Vitacura, on 27 February 2020, an action claimed by the Afinidades Armadas en Revuelta (Armed Affinities in Revolt). She was sentenced to 12 years in prison.

On June 2020, five teenagers were detained in Kansk (Russia), three were later charged with training for a terrorist attack and organising a terrorist community. In fact, they were putting leaflets in support of other imprisoned anarchists, criticised the authorities online and discussed how to make explosives and direct actions. Three people were ultimately convicted (two to probation, and Nikita got 5 years in prison).
